Children in Need Day – Friday 18 November 2011


Wycombe High School will be participating in this year's Children in Need Day on Friday 18 November.

Children in Need is a national charity which raises money for disadvantaged children and young people across the country. Last year the charity raised £18 million. The funds we raise help support grants to organisations working with children who may have experienced mental, physical or sensory disabilities; or who have behavioural or psychological disorders. Others are living in poverty or situations of deprivation, or suffering through distress, abuse or neglect.

Students and staff are invited to participate in our 'Go Dotty for Pudsy' campaign on Friday 18 November to help the charity beat the £18 million raised in 2010. We would like everyone to take part so please send your daughter into school on the day wearing an item of clothing with dots on instead of her regulation trousers or skirt, and with a £1 donation. Please note that all other school uniform rules apply – this is not a mufti day.
