

VISITOR INFORMATION



Wycombe High School is asking for the support of all of those who visit the School, its grounds or buildings in minimising the risk of COVID-19 to its community.

1. With this in mind, and in line with guidance from UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA), please refrain from entering the School site for any reason if you have any symptoms of the virus. The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of a new continuous cough or high temperature or a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia). **If in doubt, please do not enter the school site.**
2. If you live with or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19, you will not need to self-isolate if any of the following apply; you're fully vaccinated, this means 14 days have passed since your final dose of a COVID-19 vaccine given by the NHS; you're under 18 years and 6 months old; you're taking part or have taken part in an approved COVID-19 vaccine trial; you're not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons. Even if you do not have symptoms, you're strongly advised to; do daily rapid lateral flow tests (1 a day for 7 days), if you're vaccinated, to protect yourself and others from COVID-19 [find out more about daily testing on GOV.UK](#) ; follow advice on [how to avoid catching and spreading COVID-19](#); consider limiting contact with [people who are at higher risk from COVID-19](#)
3. Seek prompt medical attention if your illness or the illness of someone in your household is worsening. If it is not an emergency, contact the [NHS 111 online](#) COVID-19 service or NHS 111 for other health conditions. If you have no internet access, call NHS 111. If it is a medical emergency and you need to call an ambulance, dial 999. Inform the call handler or operator that you or someone in your household has COVID-19 or symptoms if that is the case.
4. If you have been advised to self-isolate due to travel outside the UK please do not attend site.
5. Wash your hands with soap and water (for more than 20 seconds) or use hand sanitiser regularly throughout the day, particularly after coughing, sneezing, and blowing your nose, or after being in public areas where other people are doing so.
6. Get vaccinated – [find out how to book your COVID-19 vaccine](#)
7. Lateral Flow Test twice a week even if you do not have symptoms. Please test negative before attending site.
8. Open doors and windows to let in fresh air if meeting people inside (meet outside if possible).
9. Wear a face covering when it's hard to stay away from other people – particularly in crowded places and when using public transport. Masks are required in School in communal areas
10. Keep a safe distance from other people where possible.
11. WHS clean and disinfect regularly touched objects and surfaces using regular cleaning products to reduce the risk of passing the infection on to other people.
